



Wignalls Sauvignon Blanc 2001

Winemakers Notes

Brilliantly clear, light tinge of Lime and Golden hues. Complex and uplifting Tropical fruity aromas, such as Peach and Guava, with Gooseberry and Asparagus overtones typical in a cool climate region.

2001 vintage was considered a “Brilliant” vintage in WA with mild temperatures and extremely dry conditions. “Albany” was by far no exception to this although our district was defined from the rest of WA, having experienced a late harvest compared to the normal being up to three weeks early. Our definition to the famous word “Terrior”.

A superb balance of acid and body, make this fruity wine equally refreshing as an aperitif, or as a meal accompaniment. Suggested to complement white meats such as seafood and poultry.
